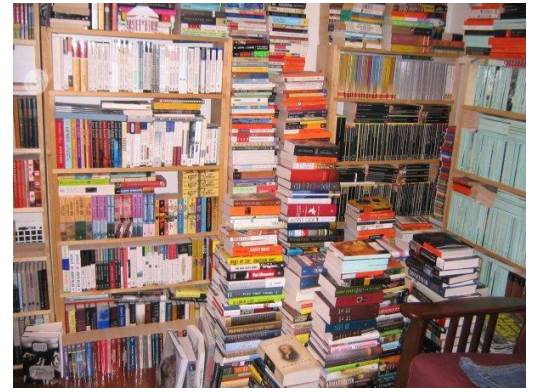


# Book Swap
